I'm encouraging students to try out a developmentally recommended pencil grip. There is an incentive for those who have been seen 10 times with a lovely pencil grip during daily work! So many things to remember: Not too tight. Not too close to the point (not on the shaved wood please), Thumb and pointer ON the pencil. The third finger rests or is along for the ride. The pencil tilts backward. There's a good image at this site as to what I like <https://www.lwtears.com/blog/how-correctly-hold-pencil> According to my training, via Handwriting without Tears, writers will have less strain and will be able to write more quickly and accurately according to the grip mentioned, so it's worth trying out!

This week we plan to do the winter AIMS web testing for reading. We have been enjoying Frog and Toad stories in both classes. In writing, we are working on realistic fiction/narrative writing. We are learning more about the process of writing: brainstorming, writing an introduction, adding details, closing, and revising and editing.
